**What is YNIA?** A week-long Catholic experience of service, community and prayer. Teens will work with children or work at agencies which feed, clothe and provide resources to the most vulnerable — community gardens, soup kitchens, homeless shelters, new immigrant support centers, senior centers, etc. They may also build, paint, and repair homes.



**Who can participate?** Any teen who was in high school during the 2017/18 school year.



**What is the cost?** \$395 (fundraising opportunities available)



**How do we get there?** Adult chaperones will drive us.



**What is the itinerary?** We will leave St. Elizabeth Seton early on Sunday, July 22. We will stop in Fonda, NY for a picnic lunch at the National Kateri Tekakwitha Shrine and Indian Museum. Arrive at YNIA site — Harvest Home Retreat Center — late afternoon. Monday-Friday work at job sites, participate in celebrations of Mass/scripture reflections and learn about those they are serving during the week. On Saturday, July 28, after eating breakfast by Niagara Falls, we'll head for home ETA by early evening.
